Friends,

Few things in this life are more annoying than telemarketers. In fact, one can scarcely sit down at the dinner table without being inundated with calls promising everything from lower credit card rates to multitudes of “special” offers. Of course, if the abundance of these calls wasn’t trouble enough, those that are unfortunate enough to answer them are almost forced to be rude in order to extricate themselves from the phone. For the tenacity and perseverance of some of these telemarketers is almost unparalleled.

But, when you stop to think about it, there is one who is vastly more determined in calling us than even the most hardened of telemarketers. That one is God. In fact, it might be helpful to think of God as the ultimate telemarketer. For not only does God promise us everything that will make us truly happy, but He is also always, and I do mean ALWAYS, calling us. Of course, unlike modern telemarketers, God’s calling should never be viewed as a nuisance. For His calls, unlike theirs, are steeped in love. The reason why can be seen most beautifully in the prophet Jeremiah. In the book of Jeremiah, the Lord says to Jeremiah, “Before I formed you in the womb I knew you.” Think about this for a minute. Before Jeremiah was ever conceived inside the womb of his mother, the Lord knew him. What does this mean?

Well, for starters, first understand that the Hebrew word translated “knew” in this passage has a much richer meaning than our English word conveys. For it is the same Hebrew word used in the book of Genesis when Adam knew his wife Eve and she conceived and bore a son. Thus, when the Lord says that He knew the prophet Jeremiah from before Jeremiah was conceived, it’s not like me saying I know Archbishop Lucas. Rather, the Lord’s knowledge of Jeremiah, even before his conception, conveys the most intimate, most experiential knowledge possible.

Naturally, the Lord uses this unique and special knowledge of Jeremiah to fit His ultimate plan for humanity. To see this simply look at the next line in the book of Jeremiah. The Lord continues, “before you were born I dedicated you, a prophet to the nations I appointed you.” You see, the Lord has created Jeremiah in an utterly unique way. No one before or since has had the abilities of the prophet Jeremiah. And so no one before or since can do what Jeremiah has been called by the Lord to do. Thus, the prophet Jeremiah plays a unique and indispensable role in the plan God has for the human race.

But in order for Jeremiah to discern his unique role in God’s plan, two things must happen. First, the Lord must call to him and, second, Jeremiah must listen. Now, contrary to what one might think, this does not happen all at once. Rather, it is a continual conversation that runs throughout Jeremiah’s life, from the first moment of his existence to his dying breath. The Lord, ever the persistent telemarketer, calls to Jeremiah. Jeremiah sometimes answers and sometimes he doesn’t; sometimes Jeremiah listens and obeys and sometimes he doesn’t. From his conversation with God, sooner rather than later, Jeremiah figures out the truth that eventually sets him free. The truth that he is only going to be happy when he does what God has called him to do.

When you think about it, this truth is almost self-evident. After all, God both knows us better than we know ourselves and loves us more than we love ourselves. Now, what good Father, armed with such immense knowledge and such immense love, is going to lead their child to a destination other than happiness? Thus, our only path to happiness is the path that God has specially designed for us based on His infinite knowledge and His infinite love of us.

You see, one might say that God is putting together the ultimate puzzle, with each and every one of us being His pieces. Each of us plays a unique and indispensable role in bringing that puzzle together. In fact, not only will our piece only fit where it is designed to be, but also without even our one piece the puzzle remains incomplete. Of course, this would be truly sad. For the image that this puzzle forms is nothing other than the face of God.

This is why it is so essential for each and every one of us to answer to the call of this most important telemarketer. And just how do we answer? There is really only one way; through prayer. We must spend some quiet time alone with God in prayer in order to LISTEN to what God has planned for us. This is why our adoration program is so important. It is also why I so rejoice that so many of you are making such an important commitment. By taking even a few minutes a week to spend some quiet time in prayer with God, we can become ever more aware of what the Lord’s plan is for our lives. Then, armed with this information, we can more easily pursue what will make us truly happy.

But, as was the case for the prophet Jeremiah, this process of discerning the Lord’s call does not come easily and it does not come overnight. Just as Michael Jordan didn’t start out as a toddler knocking down threes and throwing down tomahawk dunks, so too, we don’t start out proficient at quiet prayer. But, if we persevere in its practice, we, like Michael Jordan, WILL improve. So I encourage, if you have begun this practice of quiet prayer, persevere in it. If you have not, start today. For there is nothing that should distract us from answering this call; because it is the call to eternal life.
