Friends,

I've obviously never experienced this as a parent (although I certainly have as a child), but I'm sure it's one of the most unforgettable, and perhaps even shameful events of a parent's life. The moment that your three- four- or five-year-old toddler utters a word, or series of words, that seem more appropriate to a drunken sailor than to a small child. And even though you may have heard that word or phrase that just escaped from your child's mouth hundreds, if not thousands, of times before, there's something different about it now. As the pit in your stomach testifies, the lost innocence of a child is not something that is easy to bear.

And the major reason why the parent is so horrified by their child's indiscretion is because of their great love for their child. In fact, the more they love their child, the more their child's failings pain them. For what is in reality a relatively minor transgression horrifies loving parents so much precisely because they love their child so much.

Seen in this light, we still only begin to understand the horror God, our Father, experiences every time we sin. For regardless of how puny we may feel our sin is (in fact, regardless of how puny the sin really is relative to other sins), the offense to God is immense because God's love for us is also immense. This is why even the smallest, most seemingly insignificant venial sin, is still a horrible, gut-wrenching offense to God.

Compounding this immense pain to God's love that every sin incurs, is an equally immense affront to God's majesty. For even the tiniest, venial sin, in addition to horrifying God because of His love for us, also offends God because of His majesty. Think of it this way. Suppose I'm walking down the street and someone comes up and spits in my face. I seriously doubt that, even if it's caught on videotape, that anything significant will come from it. However, if the same thing happens to President Biden, not only would the tape run perpetually on CNN, but also the perpetrator would undoubtedly be arrested. Why? Clearly, it has to do with the office he holds. After all, the office of the president commands more dignity and respect than that of the ordinary citizen.

How much more dignity, then, does the office of God command? If the same offense becomes graver based on the person offended, then it should be clear that even the smallest sins are all nearly catastrophic precisely because they are committed against the infinite majesty of God. And this is why we can truly say that the gulf between the smallest venial sins and gravest mortal sins is still infinitely smaller than the gap between the smallest venial sin and virtue.

And it is important that we deepen our understanding of just how heinous all sin is for a number of reasons. First, it can motivate us to change, to repent. This is really the meaning of the Lenten season. During Lent especially, the Lord is calling us to repent. For even if we haven't killed anybody, our need for repentance is great. In fact, the greatest saints, when given the gift of being able to see themselves as God saw them, all nearly died of shame knowing how horrible even their smallest sins truly were.

Not only that, but also when we deepen our understanding of how horrible all sins truly are, we will better understand our dependence on God's mercy. And this will bear a number of sweet fruits! For the better we understand just how much we need God's mercy, the better we will be able to show that same type of mercy to others who need it from us!

Finally, and by far most importantly, understanding how grave all our sins truly are will help us better appreciate God's love. After all, God's love for us is truly unconditional. It doesn't grow when we do good and it doesn't diminish when we do evil, even when that evil is great. In fact, the greater that evil is, the more we appreciate God, whose love only stretches farther to reach us when we have turned farther away. And the better we appreciate how far God's love stretches for us, the better we will know just how much we are loved by God.

This is why, during the season of Lent, we pray in a special way that God will enlighten us to the true horror of our sins. Of course, if He does choose to bless us in this way, it will not be very pleasant. It will, however, be extraordinarily beneficial. For the best way to appreciate God's love for us is to understand our incredible need for it.


