My brothers and sisters in Christ,

I wish to inform you of my decision to accept a position to serve as a priest in the Diocese of Fargo, ND beginning July 1, 2023.

This decision was a long and involved process. It began during Fr. Steve's absence in the fall of 2021. At that time I began seriously questioning my vocation to serve in the Archdiocese of Omaha. In early January of 2022, I formally requested permission from Archbishop Lucas to explore options in other dioceses, which he graciously granted.

Since that meeting, my dad passed away in February and my mom has moved to Iowa. They were the last two of my family members living in the archdiocese. Additionally, one of my closest confidants died in July, and my best friend died in January of this year. The non-parishioner support system necessary for me to maintain a healthy priesthood in this archdiocese was impaired.

Providentially, the older of my two brothers moved to Fargo in June of 2022. The younger of the two plans to join him there soon. Since I firmly believe that what lies ahead for my priesthood is going to be far more difficult than anything that has happened up to this point, I have discerned that being closer my brothers and their families is the best way to ensure a healthy priesthood in the future.

The timing of this decision is unfortunate given the uncertainty surrounding the implementation of the archdiocesan pastoral plan and the merger of the two schools. Nevertheless, following our Lord's plan is always in the best interest of everyone impacted by it, and after months of prayer and discernment, I am absolutely certain this is what the Lord is calling me to do. I do not have any insight on potential replacement, but will make any announcements as soon as decisions are revealed.

My service to the Archdiocese of Omaha has brought me such incomparable joy that no expression of gratitude can ever do it justice. I am grateful to Archbishop Curtiss, Archbishop Lucas and especially the people of the parishes and schools I have been blessed to serve, for allowing me these opportunities for the past twenty-one years. Please continue to pray for me on my journey and be assured of my prayers for you.

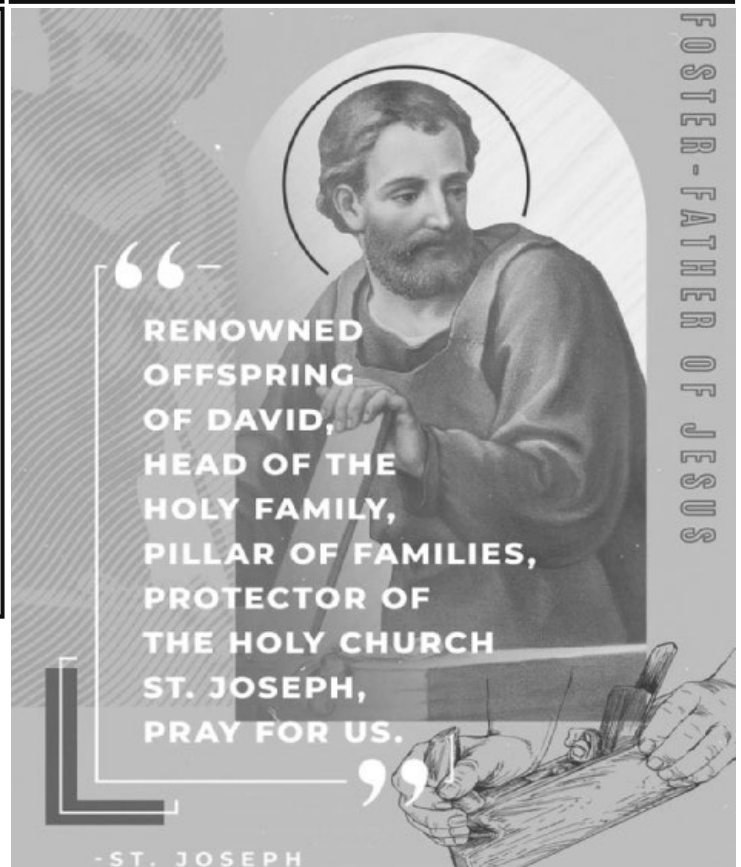
