Friends,

It's happened to all of us. That single moment of insight that strikes us so profoundly that it's like a light bulb going off in our head. Maybe it was a new idea for supper or a solution to a problem at work. Maybe it was finding a set of lost keys or simply recalling the name of the person you're speaking with. Whatever it is, we've all had moments of insight that are so profound that even the most disciplined among us find it next to impossible to keep them to ourselves.

One such moment can be found when St. John beats St. Peter to the tomb on that first Easter Morning. Only, the term "light bulb" doesn't quite capture the magnitude of this moment. For St. John's experience was probably more like the simultaneous detonation of every single nuclear warhead on the planet at the same time that the sun exploded. In fact, so profound was this experience of the empty tomb of Jesus that the only way St. John can begin to describe it is with the words, "He saw and believed."

But think about this for a minute. We're not talking here about Adolf Hitler or Osama Bin Laden. We're talking about St. John the Evangelist, the beloved disciple. The disciple who left both his nets and his father the instant Jesus beckoned him. The disciple who watched Jesus heal the blind, the deaf, the lepers, the malformed, the paralytics and those possessed by demons. The disciple who watched Jesus feed thousands with almost nothing, calm the storms with His very words, become transfigured at the top of a mountain and even raise the dead. Given all of these experiences, shouldn't St. John have believed already?

The answer is no. For St. John, despite all of the great signs he saw Jesus perform, did not yet have enough light to see the entire picture. You see, all St. John was able to see from these signs was a good man; a remarkable man. A man capable of doing things no other man in history would have even dared to attempt. A man so imbued with the light of God, that God Himself would call this man His beloved Son. A man to whom there has never been, nor would there ever be, an equal.

But bathing in the light of the Resurrection, St. John was able to see something else. St. John was able to see that this unparalleled and unprecedented man was also God. How? Well, St. John realized that there was one thing that no mere man could ever conquer. No man is capable of conquering death. And so, upon arriving at the tomb of his friend and finding it empty, the light goes on for St. John, and "he saw and believed." The man he knew as Jesus was also God.

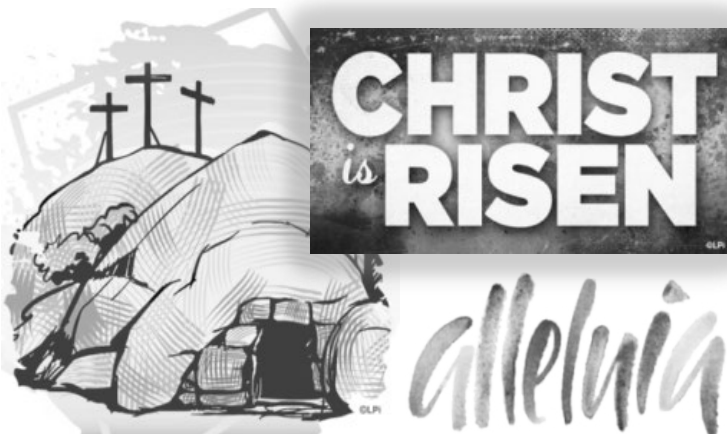

(Continued from page one.) But notice carefully what happens next. Does St. John immediately begin rejoicing, sharing his profound insight with his companions? No. St. John tells no one. Imagine that. St. John is privy to the biggest secret our planet has ever known, the secret that the man named Jesus is also God, and he says nothing. Why? Well, one of the reasons is that St. John knows his place. He knows that Jesus has placed St. Peter in charge of His Church in His absence. But St. Peter, not as beloved as St. John, has not quite figured things out yet.

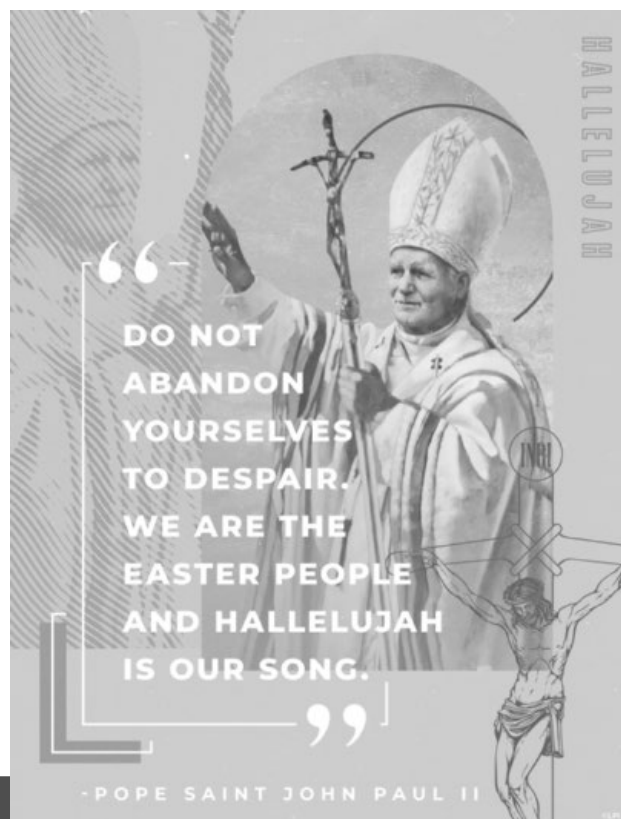
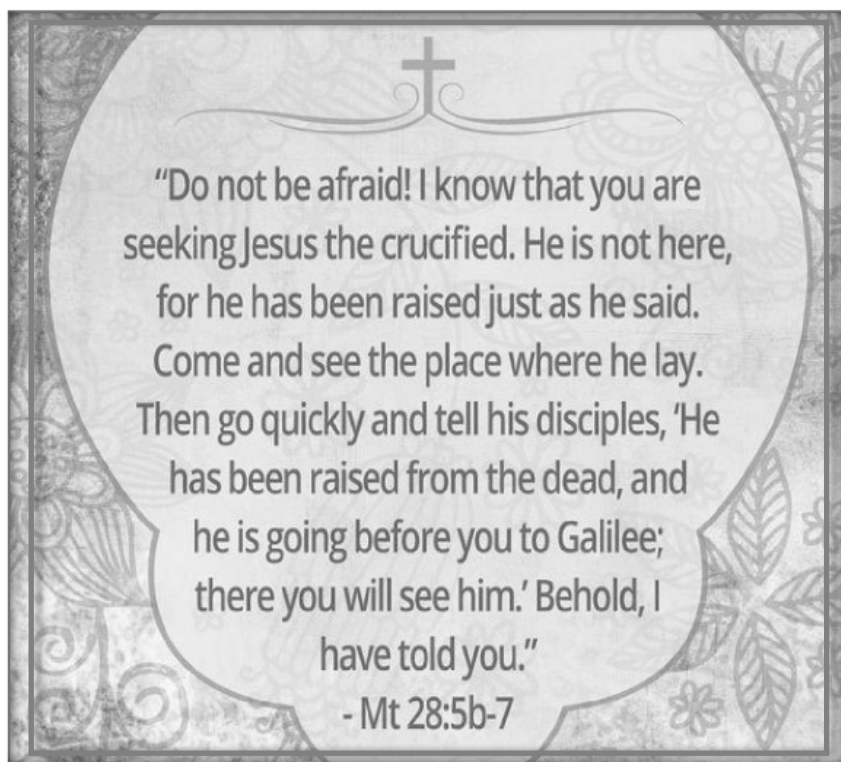
But he will. For that very night, the resurrected Christ will appear to His disciples by passing through the locked doors of the upper room. There He will proclaim to all the truth that St. John has already discovered. The truth that Jesus Christ has risen from the dead. The Truth that Jesus Christ is also God. Then everyone present will share in the excitement already enjoyed by St. John. For they, too, will see and then believe.

And what is the consequence of their belief? Well, St. John, as well as the rest of the apostles, will soon begin to share the light that was entrusted to them with the rest of the world. In fact, so infectious is the joy experienced by those apostles, that now, some two-thousand years later, nearly two billion people share the joy of calling themselves Christians.

Of course, that means there are still over four billion left to go. These are our responsibility. For, like the apostles, we, too, share in this mission of chasing away the darkness with the light Jesus has entrusted to us. This we do by sharing the joy we experience today, both in actions and in words, with all who we meet. For it is the joy that can only come from knowing the truth. And the supreme truth is not an idea, but a person; the person that this day rose from the dead; the person named Jesus that today also proves Himself to be God.
