



## MISSIONARY FR. HENRY SUNGUTI WILL BE VISITING OUR PARISHES NEXT WEEKEND!

#### Objective of Financial Mission Appeal for the Order of St. Augustine in Kenya

The Order of St. Augustine works in a suburb region called Nyamasaria near Kisumu, a town in Kenya. The poverty level in this poor area is so high. Our request of financial appeal is meant to build two classrooms and provide piped, clean water and bathrooms for our primary school in this region of the Archdiocese of Kisumu.

The Order of St. Augustine has been serving poor people in Nyamasaria since 2006 in the parish pastoral ministry. In doing so, we have discovered the big gap in the area of basic education, especially for poor children.

So we began the efforts of establishing a primary school focusing on quality education for the poor children. Currently, we only have two classrooms and a temporary kitchen. The public schools in this region are overcrowded with gender disparities, and other disparities. Many girls are left out, or have higher chances of dropping out of schools due to parents using them to do more chores at home.

Our schools will treat all children equally and promote a good school retention of the girl child. We aim to have at least 10% of children with disabilities coming from rural and slum areas. We hope to combat the social exclusion of the poorest with social scholarships and discounts. We thank you in advance and anticipate your generosity. May God bless you all.


