LITTLE SAINTS DAYCARE HIRING NEW DIRECTOR

DAYCARE DIRECTOR JOB DESCRIPTION: The daily duties for this position include, but are not limited to, managing the day-to-day operations of the center; reporting any issues with maintenance, operation or management to the licensee; hiring, scheduling and evaluating employees; billing; purchasing supplies and groceries; communicating with the parents of the daycare; keeping files organized and up to date; and handling all issues of the daycare in a professional manner. This individual is responsible for the center's compliance with rules and regulations of state licensing and sanitation. The position requires a minimum of 40 hours a week. Benefits include: full health insurance coverage, 403(b) retirement plan, PayFlex medical and dependent care, and lunch provided daily.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- The director must be 19 years of age and of good moral character.
- The director must also meet one of the following requirements:
 - 1) Hold a bachelor's or associate's degree in early childhood education, elementary education or child/youth development;
 - 2) Hold a bachelor's degree with at least six hours in early childhood education, elementary education or child/youth development;
 - 3) Have a Child Development Associate Credential;
 - 4) Have a high school diploma or GED and 3,000 clock hours of verifiable experience in organized group activities for children ages birth to 13 as indicated by a positive reference from a former employer or supervisor and either: a.) six credit hours or 36 clock hours of Department of Health & Human Services (DHHS)-approved training OR b.) a written, DHHS-approved plan to acquire at least six credit hours or 36 clock hours of DHHS-approved training.

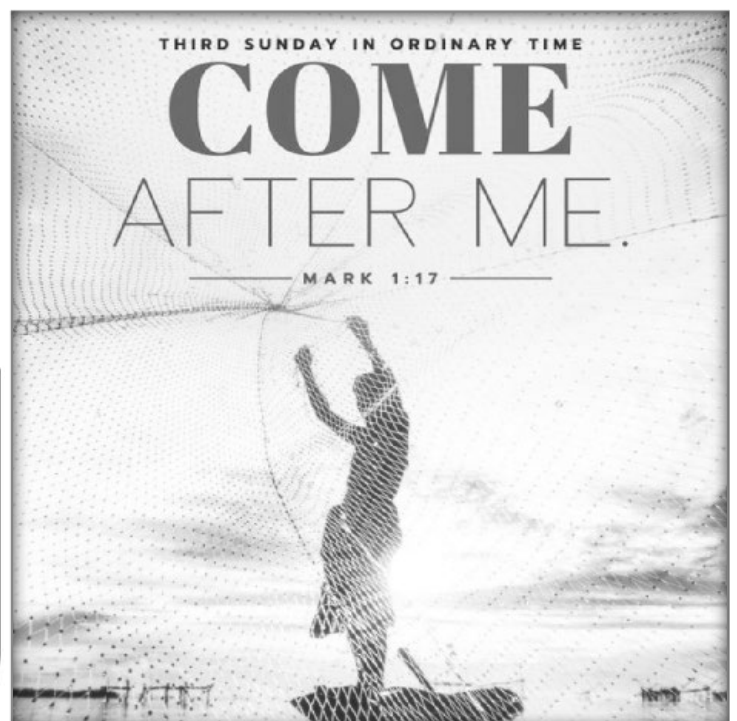

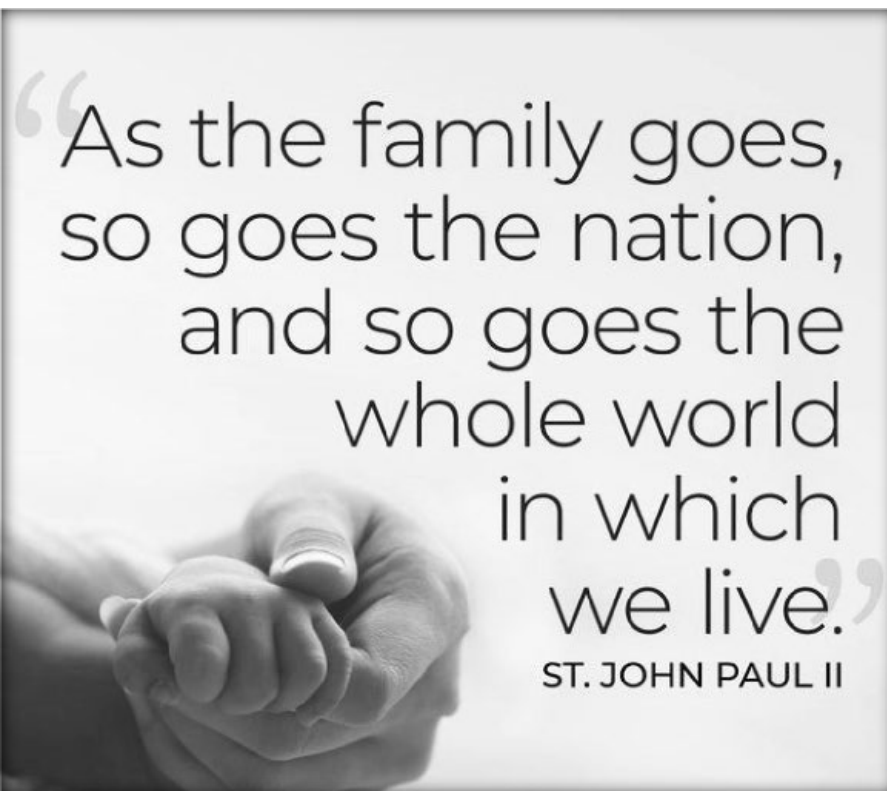
