INTERCESSORY PRAYERS TO BRO. SIMON VAN ACKEREN, A HUMPHREY NATIVE

When entering the Eucharistic Adoration Chapel in church, you will notice the pleasant colors streaming through the windows. In the center of the window on the left is a likeness of Bro. Simon (Lawrence) Van Ackeren, OFM, of Humphrey. This window once hung in a now-closed Franciscan retreat house in Indianapolis, IN, and then in the chapel of the Simon House in Columbus, NE. Mary Jo Van Ackeren, sister-in-law of Bro. Simon, generously gave it to us, stating that St. Francis Church is where it belongs.

Here is a short excerpt taken from the book <u>On Crutches to Heaven</u> by Fr. Philip Marquard, OFM, about Brother Simon Van Ackeren, OFM: "Yes, he was from Nebraska - Humphrey to be exact. He entered the world as the seventh child of Jon and Louisa Keller Van Ackeren's twelve children. It was on February 17, 1918..."

"A few days later, he was christened Lawrence by his pastor. One of his sisters wrote of him: 'His humble, sincere, devout character is something that stands out in my mind. He was always ready to work and took special joy in helping our mother in her housework. I cannot remember that he ever deliberately disobeyed.' "

"Lawrence attended the parish grade school and high school, taught by the Franciscan Sisters of Lafayette. Here he had a plugging time of it, for he was not a brilliant scholar. He finished high school (Class of 1936) and was admitted to St. Joseph Seminary in Westmont, IL. The Franciscan Friars soon realized that he could not make the grade and advised him to drop out or to apply for the Franciscan Brotherhood. He was invested with the habit of Tertiary of St. Francis on March 2, 1937.

"A year after his arrival at Teutopolis, the first signs of his fatal ailment began to appear. Though he carried on his work, it became increasingly difficult. His smiling, cheerful way would never betray the pain that he endured.

"He was hospitalized May 10, 1938. In the St. Joseph Seminary Chronicle, under the date of May 13, 1938, was entered: 'Brother Simon was a cheerful and willing worker, always at the service of his confreres. During his illness and suffering, no one heard an impatient word escape his lips. His smile never wore off, and his hours of prayer never relaxed. Resigned to God's holy will, he passed to his eternal reward the night of May 10, 1938. He was only 20 years old. To sum up Bro. Simon's life, we can well say 'Being made perfect in a short space, he fulfilled a long time.' Wisdom 4:13"

Records of miracles and answers to prayers addressed to Bro. Simon are mounting. He has been deemed the Missionaries' broker. From Heaven he is making it a specialty to look after the missions' needs. He is also active in the healing of the sick with many documented instances recorded.

If you would like to share a favor or prayer answered through Bro. Simon's intercession, we have included an updated address on the prayer cards and booklets, <u>On Crutches to Heaven</u>, in the Adoration Chapel. The family would love to hear stories of Bro. Simon's intercession.

TEC IS BEING HELD AT TINTERN RETREAT CENTER IN OAKDALE JULY 19-21.

Teens Encounter Christ (TEC) is a three-day retreat for juniors and seniors in high school, as well as college-age kids. This intergenerational movement helps youth transition into young adulthood. TEC draws participants into the heart of the Catholic faith: Christ's Paschal Mystery (His passion, death and resurrection) lived out in the Church. The weekend helps youth relate this mystery to the concrete realities of their lives and challenges them to make a deeper commitment to Christ.

The retreat schedule consists of fellowship and free time, talks given by team members, small group discussion, personal prayer, opportunities to receive the sacraments, and other group activities. TEC gives young people a safe place to ask questions, reflect on the person of Christ and who He is in their lives, and experience meaningful relationships with others. Through TEC, young people enter into a wider community that supports and sustains them, creating bonds that often last a lifetime.


