Dear Parishioners.

Just hours before His death, Jesus prayed that all believers would be one.

"I do not pray for these only, but also for those who believe in me through their word, that they may all be one; even as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that thou hast sent me." (John 17:20–21)

For months now, many eyes have been on our small parishes; watching and waiting to see how our Catholic communities would react to this testing of our faith that we have been called to endure.

When trials arise in life, it can be easy for us to be pulled towards doing what the world tells us to do. But the Bible tells us that the way to eternal life is modeling what Jesus showed us throughout His life here on earth and, even more specifically, to follow the way of the cross.

The way of the cross is not prideful, it is humble. The way of the cross is to die to self, to lay down your own life for your neighbor. It is not meant to be comfortable or easy. In fact, it may hurt - a lot. At times, it may feel humiliating. Jesus showed us this on His way to Calvary. And as much as we would like to avoid the pain that can come from humbly doing what Christ asks of us, Jesus tells us over and over that this is the way to eternal life.

Our entire family of parishes is full of faith-filled, loving, giving and hardworking people. I have witnessed the people of these communities come together to help each other through hard times over and over again. We have before us yet another incredible opportunity to come together as one and model everything that Jesus has taught us so that the world may see us and believe in Him.

Although we have already been working together in some aspects, in the coming months we will begin to more formally unite as one parish family. As we come together, we will become even stronger and more efficient; using our gifts to serve each other as one true body of Christ.

In July we will begin taking up a weekly second collection to support Catholic Education in our family of parishes. This collection will be split equally between our family's four Catholic schools (St. John Neumann elementary, St. Francis elementary, Holy Family elementary and Archangels high school) and a Parish Religious Education (PRE) fund for our family.

This is truly an opportunity for us to model Christ's teachings and follow the way of His cross, and I ask you to prayerfully consider how you might be able to contribute to this call to unity.




