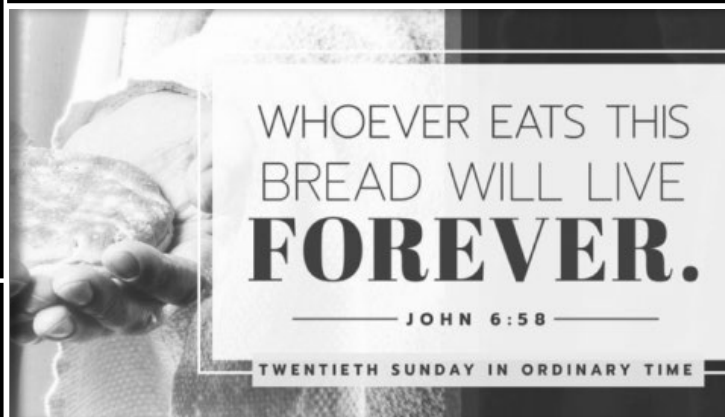

First Reading:
