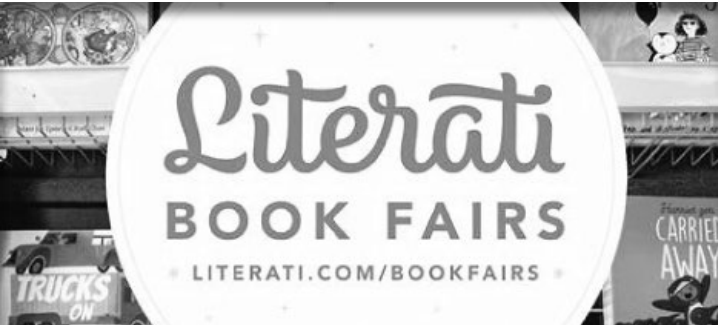

Invite Parishioners to Reflect and Respond to Scripture

First Reading:

Upon entering the Promised Land and remembering the Exodus from Egypt, both Joshua and all twelve tribes of Israel pledged their faithful to God alone. What has God done in your life that you can acknowledge and celebrate?

Second Reading:

Toward the end of his letter to the Ephesians, Paul takes up the topic of husbands and wives. He speaks of the importance of mutual respect and love. What do you add as key parts for a successful marriage?

Gospel:

John tells us that many of Jesus's disciples stopped following him because they found some of his teachings too hard to accept. What keeps you following Jesus?

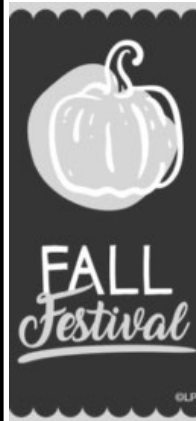

AREA EVENT: 12th ANNUAL MEMORIAL SERVICE FOR ABORTED CHILDREN

at St. Bonaventure Cemetery (14th St. & 12th Ave). On Sat., September 14, at 3:00 PM pro-life Americans throughout the country will gather at the gravesites of aborted babies and other memorial sites dedicated in their honor for the 12th annual National Day of Remembrance for Aborted Children.
