Dear Parents and Archangels Stakeholders,

If you live in District 67 you likely received a mailer about the upcoming public school bond issue. The mailer contained statements about Archangels Catholic High School, indicating that if the bond fails it could impact ACHS's accreditation. I am writing to you today to reassure you that our ability to stay accredited does **not** rely on the public school's bond passing. In fact, Archangels Catholic High School's accreditation status and the current public school bond issue are two separate and unrelated issues.

I feel it is important for you to understand the courses our students enroll in at the public school are currently being used for accreditation requirements. However, if our students are not enrolled in courses at the public school, we have several options in which accreditation requirements can be met. One option is by adjusting the courses offered by our staff. This is our preferred option. The formation of Archangels brought together a staff that has an expanded list of endorsements which could allow us to offer additional new courses in the future. Another option is through distance learning classes. Currently, Archangels is fulfilling our World Languages requirement by offering Spanish II via distance learning. A third option involves collaborating with other area schools by sharing teachers in-person or through virtual classrooms.

It is true that for many years both high schools have worked together to provide unique course offerings to students of each school. It is our desire to continue this collaboration. Archangels and Humphrey Public currently share resources in career education, for example agricultural classes, and visual and performing arts to help meet the respective requirements. The collaboration has allowed us to have a thriving local FFA chapter. The long history of collaboration between the high schools has been grounded in expanding educational offerings for our students.

Please share this information with your friends and family so that they are able to make an informed decision when voting on the bond issue. If you have any questions specific to Archangels, please ask me. If you have questions specific the public school's bond issue, there is a Humphrey Public School board meeting open to the public at 9 pm tonight in the public school library.
