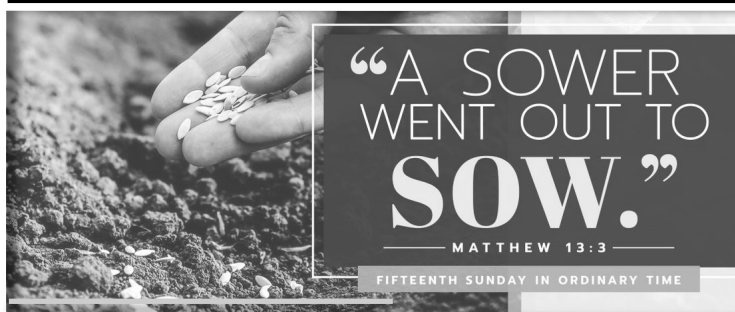

Designed With Safety in Mind

A storm shelter is a critical investment that safeguards lives by providing a safe, reinforced space to protect students and staff during tornadoes, severe thunderstorms, and other extreme weather events. Current building codes require a FEMA-rated storm shelter when constructing new educational spaces. These shelters must meet stringent standards, including a hardened enclosure with a reinforced concrete roof, emergency backup power, ventilation systems, restroom facilities, and other life-safety features. While code requirements only mandate shelter capacity for the occupants of the newly created educational spaces, the Building Committee has chosen to go beyond the minimum standard by sizing the shelter to accommodate the entire student and staff population of Archangels and St. Francis, ensuring protection for all occupants during a severe weather emergency.

The locker rooms are being designed to serve as the storm shelter within the courtyard infill portion of the new facility. Locating the shelter near the center of the building reduces travel distances, allowing students, staff, and visitors to reach safety more quickly during a severe weather event. Its centrally located, on-grade position simplifies emergency procedures, improves accessibility from all areas of the facility, and helps ensure that all occupants can be sheltered within the limited warning time often associated with tornadoes and severe storms. By incorporating the storm shelter into the locker room design, the project also maximizes the efficient use of space. The facility will serve an important daily function while remaining immediately available as a safe, code-compliant refuge whenever severe weather conditions require it.
